

Watching our parents and grandparents work on the farm daily, provided us a sense of why "hard work always pays off" and as time went on and we became older and more involved on the farms, we soon experienced this saying firsthand.

Because of the experiences on the farm, with hard work and the rewards that follow, my brother and I both quickly adapted this philosophy into our own lives and passions! We found early success in school and sports because of the upbringing and lessons learned from being raised outdoors and on the farm. From planting food-plots, mowing clover, moving trail cameras, hanging stands and even cutting in entry and exit routes, these two boys were involved in it all, every step of the way!

Our plan for the first sits of the bow season, was to sit over a BigTine Foundation Clover plot in the evenings. Trail cameras had shown multiple bucks working their way into this food-plot every evening, so our hopes were high that Easton would get an opportunity at a buck, sooner than later. As the old saying goes, "patience always pays off" and soon Easton was about to learn this lesson!

The night of our first bow hunt provided Easton and I an incredible experience! We saw nine different bucks and seven does, but what was most important wasn't the amount of deer, but the look on Easton's face the entire night! The excitement and joy that watching those deer in our food-plot, that we planted together, provided a sense of hard work paying off for my son, as well as a smile that you couldn't wipe off, even if you tried! Quickly, Easton was seeing his hard work paying off and even though none of those bucks came close enough that first night, he knew that if he was patient, he would soon be given his opportunity.

The next evening we had the exact same wind and weather conditions, as the previous evening, so we decided to head back to the Foundation Clover. We had a good feeling walking into the stand that day, as we knew what an incredible evening the day before had provided, but Easton also knew that nothing was promised!

As the evening progressed, quickly deer started pouring out into our food-plot. Does and small bucks entered at the opposite end of the food-plot first, as they typically always do. We watched them for quite some time, but none of the bucks seemed to be interested in making their way towards us.

With about 20 minutes of legal shooting light left, I caught a glimpse of a buck working a scrape to our right! Quickly, I grabbed my Leupold binoculars and to my amazement, there was the wide nine point that we had photos of all summer! Frantically, I got Easton into position to be able to watch this buck work his scrape and explained what he was doing. Easton knew the difference between rubs and scrapes, but had never actually watched a buck work one before! He was so intrigued and excited to see this buck at 80 yards and to watch him work his scrape and licking branch. With light fading fast, I could only pray that he would finish working his scrape and then head our way!

As if this buck read the script, he finished working his scrape and licking branch and did exactly what we needed, he turned and headed directly down the field edge towards our location!

As a dad, there are certain moments that we dream about experiencing with our children and this was about to be one of those moments! I knew this buck was going to present Easton a shot and I've honestly never felt so many nerves and emotions hit my body all at once, in my life! But Easton, on the other hand, was as calm as a cucumber!

The buck fed his way to 25 yards in front of us and Easton was ready and waiting! All summer we had practiced his breathing and finger control on the trigger. He knew what shot angles to take and those to stay away from, so when this buck finally became broadside, Easton knew this was his time to shine! As he clicked the safety to "off" and got down on the bow I'll never forget how time stood still! Quietly, I asked him if he had a good rest and hold on the buck and with confidence and calmness, he looked over at me and stated, "I sure do dad! This is it! I'm ready"

Easton was as excited as I've ever seen him for everyone to meet at the farm and for us to go find his buck. Our plan was to go back to the last, marked blood and let Easton lead the way from there. Quickly, Easton got on new blood and started working the trail. Not long into the search my buddy Ryan and I spotted the buck up ahead, but didn't say anything to Easton, as we wanted him to find his first deer on his own. A few minutes later, Easton looked up and saw his buck laying dead! "Dad! Dad! There he is!!" And the party was on!
