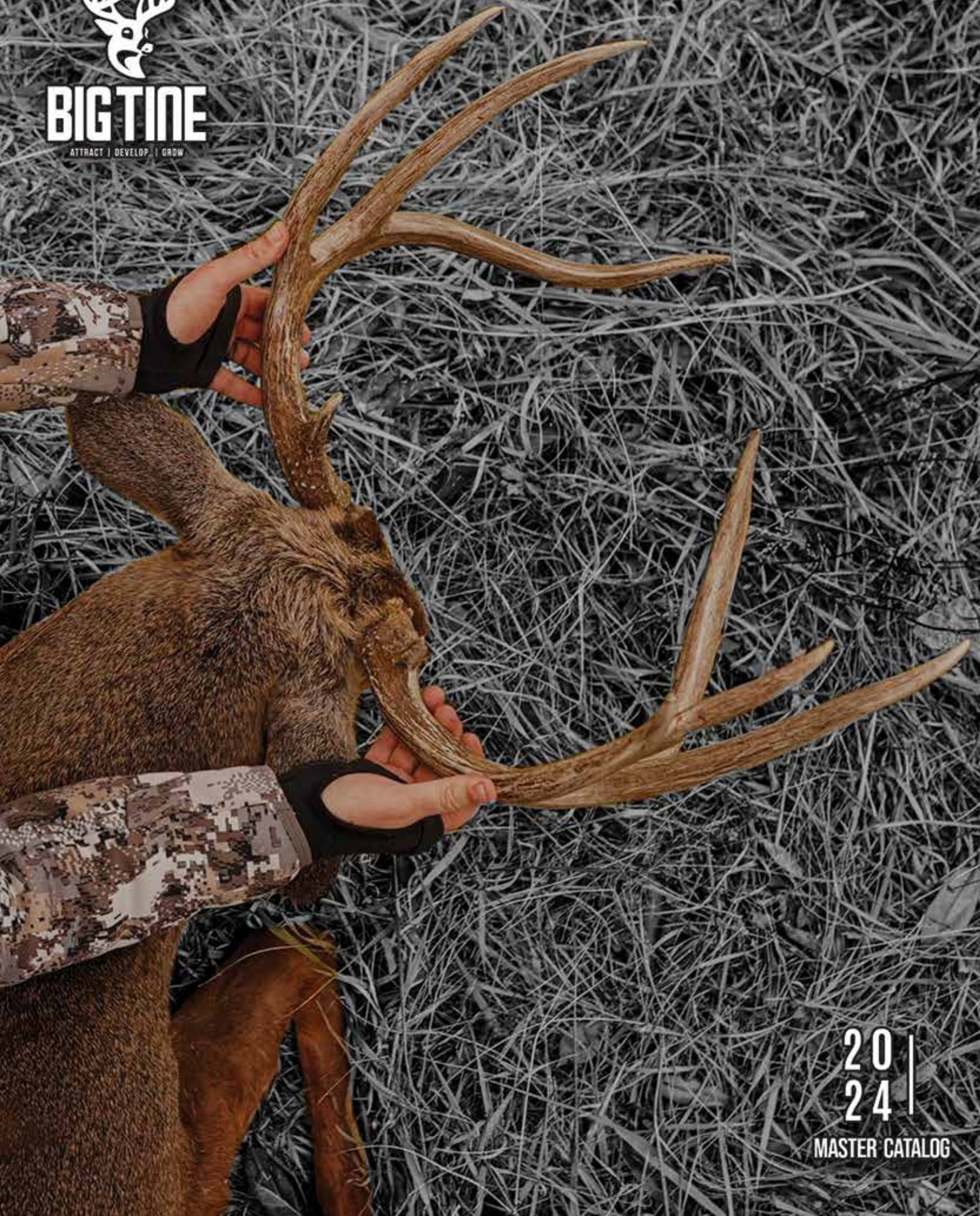

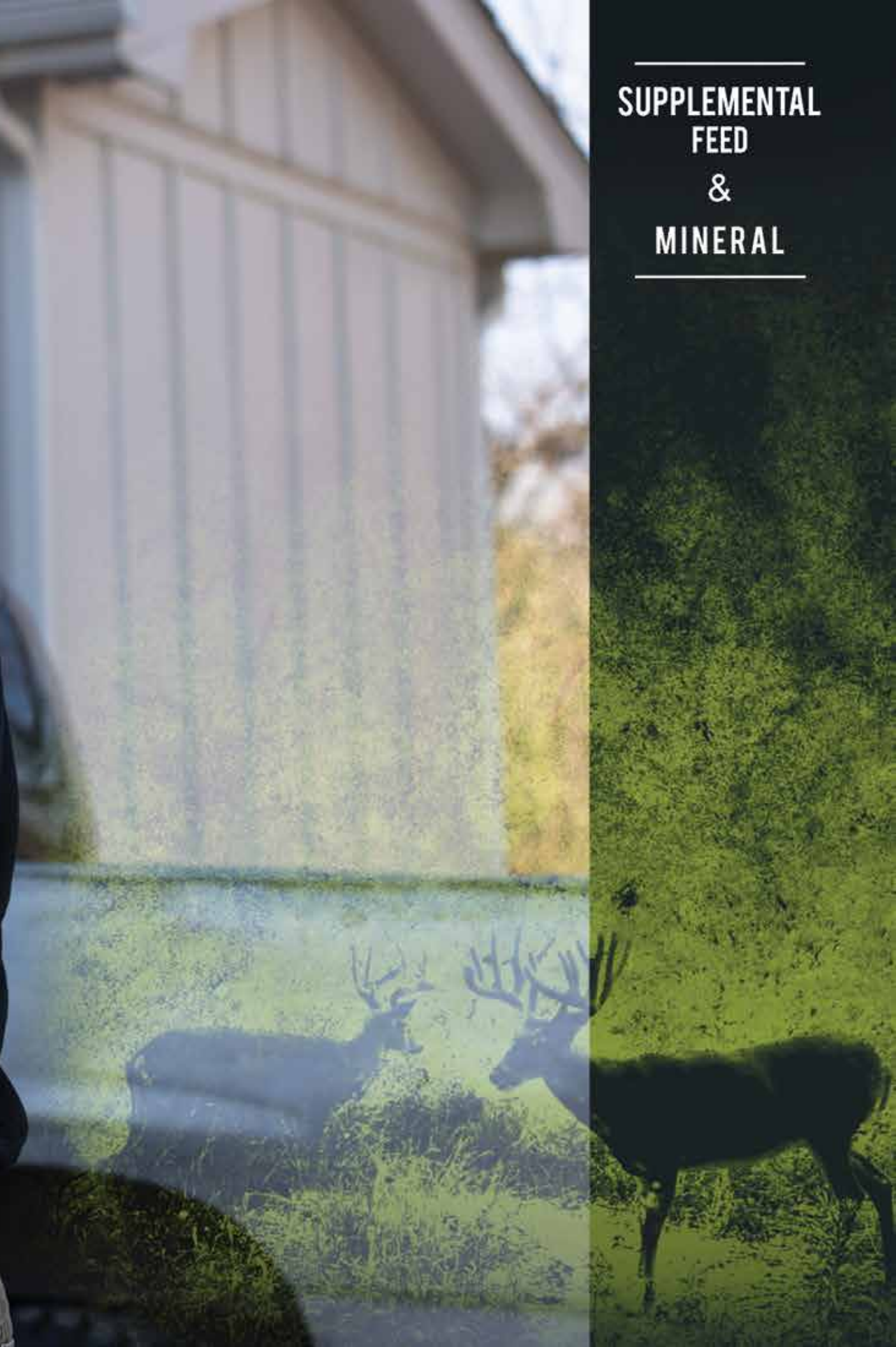

# A PASSION PROJECT WITH Unexpected Growth



In early 2015, we started the Working Class Bowhunter Podcast in a 6' x 10' closet inside a 100-year-old house. We used old secondhand desks and scrounged up some lawn chairs, all of which meant perfection to us. Our genuine obsession was bowhunting whitetail deer and of course, it was all we talked about. It was an easy decision to start recording our conversations even before podcasts were popular. We spent our first 3 years explaining the definition of a "podcast" before we could even sell people on the ideas behind WCB. We wanted to talk about hunting on a weekly basis, drink beer, hang out with friends, and keep the bowhunting flame alive in our lives. It took a lot of commitment and time, but we loved feeling like we were in deer camp every week.

We were fortunate to meet a lot of great people in the early days of WCB and stumbled into a listener base filled with the best of the best! It turns out, other hunters were craving the same deer-camp style of conversation that we just happened to be recording. We were doing what was natural for us – with or without a microphone – drinking beer and having fun over a hunting conversation. The camaraderie we built amongst our hosts and throughout our entire listener group kept us accountable to our weekly recordings from a tiny room filled with hot breath and smelly blue-collar socks. I truly believe our passion and loyalty to the podcast helped mold us into the hunters we are today and will continue to shape us into greater, more educated hunters even further down the road.

Over 8 years, we went from talking about whitetail deer in a closet to a legitimate recording studio complete with a wet bar and plenty of couches for a good night's rest in beautiful downtown New Windsor, IL! The reason behind our monumental growth has boiled down to our family of listeners. The WCB Podcast has allowed listeners to feel like they are involved in our weekly hunting camps, sitting right next to us with a drink of their choice. The conversations and guests help keep hunters motivated about their passions as they are engrossed in serious hunting conversations that almost always involve unconventional off-the-wall commentary and jokes. We are blessed to be a part of an excellent community of like-minded people.

The growth of WCB brought along partnerships and opportunities that were from our wildest dreams. It truly did the impossible – having a reason to get together every week intensified our passion for hunting and the outdoors. We've been fortunate to talk to some of the best hunters in the world! This has built a live catalog of deer hunting knowledge that applies to our audience of both new and experienced hunters. We cover everything hunting – from high level whitetail hunting tactics, to engineering our own customized Big Tine food plot, to finding success on out of state hunting trips – there is a little something for everyone. Our hosts also cover a wide range of personalities and experience levels. The uniquely funny personalities of Doug, Eric, and myself mix up with big buck killers like Austin Chandler and Ross Bigger. To our surprise, that has created hours of entertainment for hunters all over the world. When I take an airplane view of Working Class Bowhunter and the community surrounding it, I am at a loss for words.

## An Unexpected Style?

I'll never forget the day I sat down at the Archery Trade Association (ATA) show near Jim Shockey. Here I was, holes in my ears and tattoos on my skin yet somehow at a hunting industry-specific event. I stuck out like a sore thumb, but it didn't take long for people to accept a fresh perspective, and after a few years of recording consistent weekly podcast episodes, we noticed we were starting to get some attention. The growth in our listener base and some industry recognition started to tell us we were doing something right despite the growing number of tattoos. At this time podcasts were fairly new to the outdoor industry; the only available shows included tame, clean, and straight-forward conversation. Coming from blue-collar/construction job sites and hunting camps, we had a different idea of what people wanted to hear. We brought our genuine lifestyle straight into our show and didn't hold back one bit. Love it or hate it, we have always been transparent, honest, and lighthearted during every episode. This was a total shock to most people who were accustomed to the standard network TV hunting shows. We've stuck to a few goals: always be genuine and unscripted, learn a few things, and entertain the listener who might just have a non-hunter within ear shot on the jobsite or in a work truck.

## Hunting Tactics: Putting in the RIGHT Effort

Over 600 episodes in and getting the chance to have full conversations with some really amazing people definitely has its advantages. We have learned a ton from what we consider the hunting "pros" and applied it to our own hunting game plans. Learning what, when, where, and how to plant food plots is a great example of that. We were fortunate enough to shoot THREE of our crew's biggest archery bucks in the 2023 season! Eric found success over a Big Tine plot, plus Doug and I found success on patterning and making calculated moves. The right preparation can definitely lead to the right opportunities!

You might be wondering; what does Working Class Bowhunter Podcast have to do with Big Tine and why are you reading about this in their 2024 catalog? At the ground level, we know and represent that Big Tine is for the regular guys and gals just chasing passions and doing what they can to be successful in hunting. Big Tine has given us that exact opportunity – to chase our aspirations – both as a business and in our deer hunting. We know they do the same for their customers; Big Tine helps create opportunity and progression in deer hunting and property management.

We have had an absolute blast with our passion project of "WCB" and we are just getting started. We sincerely send our appreciations to Big Tine and their team for being one of our biggest supporters, as well as ANYONE who has ever endorsed us. It has been a dream and we are so excited to keep creating fun and refreshing content in an ever-evolving hunting world. # WHAT'S THE PURPOSE OF FERTILIZER?

Fertilizer is a source of nutrients that all plants need to survive. Fertilizer must be supplemented based on the needs of the soil. Some soils hold the necessary nutrients better than others, but in most cases even the best soils need at least some key nutrients added to optimize a plant's growth health. The three most notable nutrients found in a common bag of fertilizer are Nitrogen, Phosphorous and Potassium (N-P-K). Without the proper pH and fertilizer plants simply cannot reach their optimal forage production which results in a waste of time and money and does not offer much in the way of helping wildlife. The purpose of this article is to breakdown how to calculate and understand a posted fertilizer analysis, and explain what each of the common nutrients (N-P-K) are responsible for in a plant.

## UNDERSTANDING FERTILIZER

The three numbers most commonly seen on a bag of fertilizer represent the primary three nutrients, Nitrogen, Phosphorus and Potassium. For this ratio, one 50 lb. bag of 17-17-17 fertilizer will contain 8.5 lbs. of each element in the ratio. (For example: If you apply 300 lbs. of 17-17-17 per one acre, you will be applying 51 lbs. of Nitrogen, 51 lbs. of Phosphorus, and 51 lbs. of Potassium over the acre.) Fertilizer can be purchased in bag form from many types of stores, but options can be somewhat limited. If following a soil test's recommendations, you may have to purchase multiple kinds to achieve the ratio called for in the test. Understanding the breakdown above should help in purchasing or putting together a mix that will get you close to the test requirements. Fertilizer can also be purchased in bulk and custom blended from many farm or co-op type stores. If fertilizing multiple acres, buying in bulk may be the most economical method.

## WHAT IS EACH ELEMENT RESPONSIBLE FOR?

### Nitrogen (N)

- Promotes plant growth.
- Improves overall plant health.
- Major component of chlorophyll and amino acids
- Supports plant tolerance to heat, cold and drought.

### Phosphorous (P)

- Assists in early plant development and photosynthesis.
- Stimulates root development.
- Aids nitrogen fixing capacity for legumes such as clover, soybeans and alfalfa.
- Supports earlier plant maturity.

### Potassium (K)

- Improves resistance to drought, disease, and heat.
- Assists in water uptake.
- Increases winter hardiness.
- Enhances overall health and plant vigor.

Knowing these basics is a step in the right direction for food plot success. Although there are generalized fertilizer recommendations on each Big Tine product bag, Big Tine recommends a laboratory soil test be performed to determine what nutrients are needed and in the proper ratios. A laboratory soil test is an inexpensive way to potentially save money on fertilizer and other input costs by analyzing exactly what is needed for the seed you are planting.
